Further to my meeting on 8 March 2010 with Oli Rodker regarding your future plans for Greenham Reach, I confirm that Devon Wildlife Trust would be delighted to help you establish biodiversity monitoring protocol for your land.

Over the next 2 years, i.e. in 2011 and 2012, I can confirm that Devon Wildlife Trust are prepared to give you one full day of Project Officer time, free of charge. This work will either be provided by our County Wildlife Sites Officer or local Nature Reserve Officer who looks after Devon Wildlife Trust Nature Reserves within the Blackdown Hills area.

We are quite flexible about how you utilise our time and expertise. Options discussed so far include the provision of on-site advisory visits, assistance with survey and data gathering or acting in an auditory role as we help you establish management criteria for your tenants.

Given the current habitat mosaic at Greenham, we consider this to be a site of great potential for local wildlife. Devon Wildlife Trust will be delighted to work in partnership with the ELC to maintain and enhance this value. We look forward to hearing how your plans proceed.
